









Devotion to the Holy Face of Jesus – A gathering to pray, reflect and meditate upon the Holy Face of Jesus is held at **7:45 p.m. every first Tuesday of the month** at St. Paul Co-Cathedral, 720 Spadina Crescent East in Saskatoon, with the next gathering at 7:45 p.m. **Tuesday, April 1.** The devotion consists of the Chaplet to the Holy Face, and prayers of reparation, and takes about 30 minutes. Participants typically stay afterwards for questions, shared stories, and personal meditation. **Everyone is welcome.**

Challenge yourself this Lent with the Lenten 40: A 40-km relay run/walk along the river in Saskatoon, is held right before Holy Week on **Saturday, April 12.** Meditate on the suffering of Jesus and think of the Via Dolorosa (the path Jesus took on his way to the crucifixion, often translated to “the way of suffering”). Whether you're an avid runner or have never run before, this is about showing up and giving it all to God. Sign up as a team of two, three, or four. See: www.lenten40.com. Stations of the Cross will be prayed the night before Friday, April 11 at 7 p.m. at the Cathedral of the Holy Family, and the Lenten 40 event begins at 8 a.m. Saturday, April 12 with package pick-up and prayer; the walk/run begins at 9 a.m.

Prairie Pilgrimages during this Jubilee Year will have a special significance, reflecting the Jubilee theme “Pilgrims of Hope” and providing an opportunity for a special Jubilee spiritual indulgence. Plans are underway for annual events at Blumenfeld **June 8**, Grosseverder **June 13**, Reward **July 13**, and Mount Carmel **July 20** -- all in the Roman Catholic Diocese of Saskatoon. There are other nearby summer pilgrimages in the Ukrainian Catholic Eparchy of Saskatoon, including at Cudworth June 14-15, and at the Pro-Life Millennium Cross Sept. 14, and in our sister dioceses of Prince Albert, including St. Laurent July 15-16, and the archdiocese of Regina, including Rama Aug. 14-15.
